WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

Overview

Please read this Privacy Policy and the site Terms and Conditions of Use before using this site.

The Privacy Policy set out below shall apply to all users of the site. The terms 'you', 'your' and 'user' refer to any individual and/or business accessing this site for any reason. References to 'we', 'us' and 'our' are references to BAB. The information we collect from you is only that required by us in order to provide you with the information you have requested and to improve the service we provide. Except as provided in this Privacy Policy, we do not supply your personal information to any other person.

Personal Information

In general, we gather information about all of our users collectively, such as what areas you visit most frequently and what services you access the most. We only use this anonymously and aggregated with other users' information to protect your privacy. The information collected helps us determine what features and services are of most benefit to you in order to create the best possible service for you.

Specific Information

In some instances, such as when you register as a member of BAB to access the members area of our website or enter a competition, we may require more specific information about you, such as name, e-mail address, postcode etc. We use this information to verify your BAB membership, to make you aware of new services, which may be of interest to you, or to contact you regarding site changes and updates. General Information

We do not disclose your individual visits to our site, or personal information that you provide, such as your name, e-mail address, postcode, etc., to any outside parties, except when we believe the law requires it. We are not responsible for any information inputted outside our site.

Online Surveys

www.bab.org.uk values your opinion and comments, so we may from time to time conduct online surveys. Your participation in these surveys is entirely optional. Typically, the information is aggregated and used to make improvements to the site and to develop appealing content, features and promotions for you. Your contribution to any survey will be anonymous unless otherwise stated in the survey.

Feedback

Please submit any feedback to us. Feedback is used primarily for internal purposes to aid us in improving the site. Any feedback submitted becomes our property and we may use feedback, such as success stories, for marketing purposes, or to contact you for further feedback. We will

Cookies

'Cookies' are small pieces of information that are stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. IP Addresses and Log Files

We capture industry standard information contained in the server log file, such as browser type, pages visited, entry and exit points and visit duration solely for the purposes of analysis. Information contained in log files is intended for internal use only and will not be disclosed to our Partners. The aggregate logged information is not linked to any personally identifiable information.

The British Aikido Board was established in 1977. It is recognised by Sport England as the only governing body for Aikido in the United Kingdom. The constituted purpose of the British Aikido Board is to further the advancement of all styles of Aikido in the United Kingdom and to establish and monitor standards of safety and behaviour conducive to the safety of practitioners of Aikido. The Board acts as an agent for insurance which is compulsory for both students and instructors. It also promotes a nationally recognised coaching scheme and is dedicated to guiding the development and implementation of a nationally recognised coaching system in conjunction with Sports Coach UK. The Board controls the administration of insurance and coaching and promotes a code of conduct and other rules to ensure control and regulation; it also frames future policy and direction based on changing circumstances and legislation arising both in the UK and through the European Community. The Board itself, is an association not club based vehicle; the membership ranges from national to regionally based associations. Member associations remain independent both technically and financially.

Data Protection

We are registered under the Data Protection Act 1998. Our use of personal information supplied by you when you use this site is governed by our Privacy Policy which can be found on the site, and which you are advised to read.

Use of Material
